**Eytan Sivak** is a dance pedagogue and artist working internationally, creating commissioned works as well as independent dance projects.

Eytan danced many leading roles in companies such as The Cullberg Ballet and Scapino Ballet and worked with numerous renowned choreographers such as Mats Ek, Ohad Naharin, Ed Wubbe and Nils Christie.

During his career, Eytan was chosen by Ballettanz magazine as one of the year's most outstanding dancers internationally. For his role as The Prince in Mats Ek's production of Sleeping Beauty he was described by Frankfurter Allgemeine Zeitung as the Robert de Niro of dance.

He is presently head teacher at The Ballet Academy of Stockholm where he also works with development of future education for dance and stage artists.

Eytan's recent stage appearance was during the Spring of 2023 as guest dancer with The Royal Swedish Ballet in Mats Ek's production of Julia and Romeo.
